The Department of Posts released a postage stamp in memory of Dada Saheb Phalke Award winner LV Prasad, on Tuesday

and Milan not only paved the way for new kind of films but also gave a wonderful actor Kamal Haasan to Hindi cinema.

Health Minister Rosaiah released a book on LV Prasad. The programme began with a


prayer song and a short documentary followed soon.
